News from the Rubber Division

- 1. <u>Rubber Division 2010 Meetings</u>: The Rubber Division's Spring Meeting will be held at the Hilton Akron/Fairlawn Hotel (Fairlawn, Ohio) on April 26-28, 2010. Registration and Housing are open on the Division website, www.rubber.org. Early registration deadline is April 11, 2010. A couple of changes this year will be that only governance committees and Program Planning Committee will meet at the spring meeting AND there will not be a Chairs Reception this year due to budgeting constraints. The Division's fall meeting will be held in Milwaukee on October 12-14. The Call for Papers for the technical symposia and an updated floor plan are available on the Division website. There still is time to reserve a booth for your company at the fall expo. The Division will manage logistics for the Tire Society Annual Conference to be held at the Four Points Hotel (adjacent to the Hilton Akron/Fairlawn Hotel) in Fairlawn, Ohio on April 20-21, 2010.
- 2. <u>District Science Fair for Local High Schools</u>: The Western Reserve District 5 Science Fair will be held on Saturday, March 20, 2010 at The University of Akron Student Union. The Rubber Division is again offering a \$100 prize for the winner in Chemistry. If anyone would like to judge the entries for Chemistry, please let Ed Miller know at emiller@rubber.org or 330-972-6527. He will be able provide you more information as well as to give you the \$100 check for the "Award for Chemistry" for you to present (if you wish to do so). These are excellent venues to recognize local high school students in science and chemistry and to identify future chemists for your company.
- 3. <u>Science and Technology Awards</u>: Nominations are being accepted for the Division's six Science & Technology Awards. Details on nomination packages for each award can be found on the Division's website. All nominations for S&T Awards are due to the Division's Executive Director by July 15th. The S&T Awards Committee will meet in August to select recommended winners.
- 4. <u>New ACS Requirement for Rubber Groups</u>: Starting this year, each Subdivision (Rubber Group) must send a copy of their 2009 Form 990, 990EZ or 990N to the ACS National Tax Office in order to retain your non-profit status through their group exemption. In order to make sure this is done in the most efficient way, each Rubber Group has been requested to send an electronic copy to the Division Accounting Manager Lakisha Miller at lmiller@rubber.org. She will then collect these and forward as a package to ACS.
- 5. <u>Biomedical/Biomaterial Show</u>: The 2010 Division Chair and Executive Director met on February 24th with a small group of organizational representatives interested in exploring a partnership with the Rubber Division to expand the Rubber Expo to include a Biomedical/Biomaterial Show for fall 2011. This would include a second technical symposium around biomaterial innovations and biomedical applications as well as educational workshops of this nature. The group included the following representatives: Chair Tim Dickerson; Expo & Meetings Manager Beth Berkheimer; Executive Director Ed Miller; University of Akron Dean, College of Polymer Science & Polymer Engineering Dr. Stephen Cheng; Aram Nerpouni (representing Bioinnovation Institute CEO Frank Douglas); Denise Richardson (representing Bioenterprise Inc CEO Baiju Shah); UA Professor Dr. Judit Puskas; UA Professor Dr. Matt Becker; Northeast Ohio Universities & Colleges of Medicine President Dr. Walter Horton; and IX Center President Bob Peterson. The Chair and Executive Director are developing an information package for the Executive Committee to review. If this new direction is approved, it would retain the core Rubber Division expo and technical programs, while expanding technical and marketing opportunities for our members and their companies.

Technical Presentations

"Commercial Tire Market and Selected Aspects of Tire Technology Trends"

Brendan Rodgers, ExxonMobil Chemical, Global Specialty Polymers Technology

The commercial tire market primarily centered on heavy duty truck tires for both on and off road service has not seen the substantial changes the consumer market has seen such as the introduction of "green" technologies. However major changes have occurred such as the expansion of the use of wide base single tires on drive axles, sealant technologies, and use of introduction of mileage steer axle tires. Effective uses of materials have been an enabler for these new designs. The review will discuss some of these materials technologies and their contribution to improved tire performance.

"Economic and Political Challenges in the Tire Industry"

Roy Littlefield, Executive Vice President, Tire Industry Association

The two greatest challenges facing the tire industry are economic and political. Facing the greatest economic challenges of the past seven decades, a company's profitability represents the largest economic challenge. We all need to investigate our options. Roy will discuss Chinese tariffs, card checks, cap and trade, proposed employer mandates and environmental regulations which may be obstacles to your business' success. Explore next steps you may need to take to lobby your lawmakers to make decisions which best suit the goal of competing in a global economy and how you can contribute in these efforts.
