Division News from the Area Director

Andrew Tisler, Cytec Industries, Inc.

- 1. Spring 2011 Technical Meeting: The spring technical meeting will be held on April 18-20, 2011 at the Hilton Akron/Fairlawn Hotel. Registration and housing are open, with a pre-registration discount offered until April 4th. The complete Technical Session for the spring meeting is now available online at (http://rubber.confex.com/rubber/179/webprogram/INVITED.html) or you can go to the website, www.rubber.org, under Events and see details. Note that Dr. Avraam Isayev's presentation (George Whitby Award winner) will be held at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday and will be added once he submits his Abstract via confex. Also, remember that this year, there will be a general Welcome Reception held on Monday, April 18th, open to all attendees. A new Welcome Reception Sponsorship is available for \$150 and includes logo on signage, company name in meeting program and a designated table (limited number available). - 2. <u>Strategic Planning Task Force</u>: The Strategic Planning Task Force (Tim Dickerson, Leo Goss, Bill Stahl, Leonard Thomas, Doug Ruch and Ed Miller) is nearing completion of the draft Strategic Plan for the Rubber Division. Recommended core function action items are based upon the 2010 Comprehensive Survey. This draft plan will be presented to the Steering Committee at the 2011 Spring Meeting in Akron and then to the Executive Committee for final approval. Once approved, the key committees within the core functions will develop Business Plans to implement action items. The final plan will be added to the Division's website after approval.
- 3. <u>Lab Procedures Assessment Task Force</u>: Tim Dickerson is leading a Lab Procedures Assessment Task Force to develop the process and procedures for a proposed new service offered by the Rubber Division. This would allow companies to request an assessment of their laboratory in meeting required testing procedures and specifications to assure they are in compliance. The task force is also seeking volunteer experts to perform the analysis for a fee plus a fee would be paid to the Rubber Division.
- 4. Education and RCT: The Rubber Division is holding the following educational course in conjunction with the Ohio Rubber Group's Technical Meeting: "The Right Elastomer For Your Sealing Application", by instructor Bill Stahl. This will be held at the Hilton Garden Inn Hotel in Twinsburg OH from 2-4 p.m. on Tuesday, April 12th. To register, go to the Division's website, www.rubber.org and sign up via the on line Division Store. The Fall Educational Symposium sponsored by Trostel, Ltd includes six courses, with the possibility of more being added. The Division currently has six webinars available on line, with three more in progress. The newest webinar is "Mixing and Testing for Compound Consistency" by Joe Walker. The Division is holding a joint educational course at the ASM International show in Minneapolis MN this August. More details to follow soon on the Division's website. The Rubber Chemistry & Technology Journal Peer X-Press paper submission system and the entire backlog from 1928-present of RCT journal articles are all available on AIP's system.
- 5. <u>Part Time Positions</u>: The new Marketing & Membership Assistant is Heather Maimone. Additionally, a temp (Craig Hornish) is filling in for Meetings & Executive Assistant Melanie Avdeyev, who is on 10 weeks Maternity Leave. Interviews were completed for the part time Library position and the job is being offered to Charles Brady. Actual start date has not yet been confirmed.
- 6. Other Conferences: In addition to the Rubber Division's spring (April 18-20/Hilton Akron-Fairlawn Hotel) and fall (October 10-13/IX Center Cleveland) meetings, there will be three other conferences this year. First is the "International Union of Pure and Applied Chemists" (IUPAC) conference to be held at the Goodyear Polymer Center, University of Akron, on July 10-15, 2011. Housing and registration are open for this conference. See our website at www.rubber.org. Second is the "Tire Society's Annual Conference" to be held at the Hilton Akron/Fairlawn Hotel on September 13-14. See our website to link to the Tire Society website. Third is the "Fifth Annual Rubber Modified Asphalt Conference" to be held on November 3-4, 2011 at the Capital Sheraton Hotel in Austin TX, in conjunction with the FHWA's "Industrial Byproducts in Highway Construction Conference". The Rubber Manufacturers Association is handling all logistics for this conference. Details soon to be added to our website.


